



If you are a citizen of Belarus and want to study in the Polish or English language at a higher education institution in Poland as part of the 'Solidary with Students' measure, this leaflet will show what you should do next.



Take part in the recruitment process at one of the following higher education institutions:

Follow the recruitment rules and observe the time limits set by the higher education institution of your choice. You can apply for all full-time fields of study conducted in Polish and English except for applying for philology studies (except for the Polish language studies).



Decision regarding your admission to the higher education institution

The decision regarding your admission will be made by the higher education institution, in accordance with its recruitment rules. If you are admitted, you should do the following:



Apply for the NAWA scholarship at your higher education institution

Ask the international cooperation department to send your application for the 'Solidary with Students' scholarship offered by NAWA.



Information for Students

The higher education institution will make a decision based on its internal rules and inform you if you are a successful candidate. If you are awarded the scholarship, you should do the following:



Contact NAWA

Register in the NAWA IT system.

Important: you can come to Poland only if you have a valid visa. Beneficiaries of the 'Solidary with Belarus' scholarship must legalize their residence after coming to Poland.

Rules governing the 'Solidary with Belarus' scholarship

- the scholarship is awarded for a maximum period of 10 months in the academic year 2020/2021
- the scholarship holder is exempted from education fees during the academic year 2020/2021
- monthly scholarship amounts to PLN 1,250.00 at the first-cycle studies, and PLN 1,500.00 at the second-cycle studies
